Entrance examinations can be roughly divided into two types.

One is "General Admission" which anybody who graduated (or will graduate) from a junior high school can take,

and the other is "Special Admission" which persons who fulfill special conditions can take.

Special Admission can be further divided into two: Special Admission for Prefectural Foreign Residents, etc. and Special Admission for Students Returning from Abroad.

Eligibility for Special Admission for Prefectural Foreign Residents, etc.

A, B, C and D are conditions
for General Admission.

Documents required for Application

Here is Eligibility for "Special Admission for Prefectural Foreign Residents, etc." on page 5 of the Guidebook.

Eligible persons are who fulfills both E and F in addition to A, B and C or A, B and D.

Condition E is: Persons who will have stayed in Japan for 6 years or less in total as of February 1, 2023, after entering Japan excluding the period of stay before entering elementary school.

A document such as Passport is required to certify the period of stay.

It is explained on page 6.

Condition F is: Persons who have foreign nationality, or who obtained Japanese nationality in the past 6 years (as of February 1,2022).

A document such as Passport or Certificate of Nationality is required.

It is explained on page 6.

If you are not sure about your eligibility, please consult with your Junior High School teacher or Kanagawa Prefectural Board of Education personnel without fail.
