Entrance examinations can be roughly divided into two types.

One is "General Admission" which anybody who graduated (or will graduate) from a junior high school can take,

and the other is "Special Admission" which persons who fulfill special conditions can take.

Special Admission can be further divided into two: Special Admission for Prefectural Foreign Residents, etc. and Special Admission for Students Returning from Abroad.

**Special Admission
for Students Returning from Abroad**

A, B, C and D are conditions
for General Admission.

Special Admission for Students Returning from Abroad (Application accepted by 8 full-time high schools. ➤ P.13)	Persons who fulfill condition G in addition to A, B and C above G Persons who lived in foreign countries for two years or more consecutively because of their guardians' work location, etc. and <u>returned to Japan on or after April 1, 2019</u>

Documents required for Application

Here is Eligibility for "Special Admission for Students Returning from Abroad" on page 5 of the Guidebook. Eligible persons are who fulfills G in addition to A, B and C.

Condition G is: Persons who lived in foreign countries for two years or more consecutively because of their guardians' work location, etc. and returned to Japan on or after April 1, 2019

Documents such as Passports of the guardian and the applicant are required.

It is explained on page 6.

If you are not sure about your eligibility, please consult with your Junior High School teacher or Kanagawa Prefectural Board of Education personnel without fail.
