This is the interview sheet which is to be prepared by yourself and submitted to the high school you are taking entrance examination for together with the application form.

It is required by most of the high schools.

This sheet should include:

1. "Why do I want to enter this high school?"
2. "What I tried hard in studies in junior high school"
3. "What I actively engaged in clubs, committees and volunteer activities"
4. "My strong points"

The interview sheet is used as a reference at the time of the interview.

The contents of the sheet will not be evaluated as a part of the examination.

The interviewing teacher considers what to ask reading the sheet. You should write about things you want the interviewer to ask you and things you want to emphasize.

If you think your Japanese proficiency is not enough, you can write in your own language, ask somebody to translate it into Japanese and copy it by your hand.



Let's take a look at the Interview!

An interview is conducted in each of the General Admission and the Special Admission.



You have an interview by yourself.

It is about 10 minutes per person.

Interview question topics include what you wrote in the interview sheet.

Practice many times so that you will not get nervous.

Essential Points in an Interview

1) Answer in a loud and clear voice.

2) Be mindful about clothes and attitude!

3) When you do not understand a question,

say,

「すみません。もう一度お願いします。」

Essential points in an interview:

1) Answer in a loud and clear voice.

2) Have an interview in a school uniform if you are a junior high school student.

If you are not enrolled in a junior high school in Japan, decent clothes such as a blazer is recommended.

Have an interview in a respectful manner.

3) If you do not understand a question, it is not good to remain silent.

Say "Sumimasen. Mo ichido onegaishimasu." which means "I'm sorry but can you please say that again?"
